Record of Proceedings

(Date of Hearing: 23.02.2024)

- 1). Commission heard the petitioner.
- 2). Petitioner submitted that the tariff petition for FY 2022-23 is not yet decided whereas a time for petition for FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25 has fallen due. Therefore, it is prayed to allow a fresh petition for these years including true up for past years.
- 3). The respondent has placed the matter of non-availability of tariff beyond FY-21-22. Respondent also submitted to include the "State Transmission Utility (STU) as party to this, being actual user of the transmission line.
- 4). Commission enquired petitioner for the time they need to file fresh petition for which petitioner agreed for a time period of four weeks.
- 5). Commission also asked the petitioner to file the following facts and records, while submitting the fresh petition.
 - i). Whether the approval of Commission was taken by the licensee for the Cost/DPR of this transmission line before investment ?
 - ii). For what quantity of power the transmission line is capable of ?
 - iii). What quantity of power is getting injected by Licensee as Generation licensee too ?
 - iv). What quantity of power other transmission licensees are injecting in this ?
 - v). Is the expenditure incurred for this line is unduly passed on to consumers because of its underutilisation ?
- 6). On the submission of respondent to include the STU as the party to the case, Commission allowed to include STU as interested party.

After hearing the parties, Commission allowed the petitioner to file a fresh petition before 15.03.2024, and arrange to deliver the copy to the respondent parties too.

With the above the petition No. **TP-03 of 2022** is disposed of.
