2. The Petitioner's representative Er. Duyu Tacho, Chief Engineer (P) (Comm), Department of Power,

Government of Arunachal Pradesh in its submission has stated that as the Power Purchase

Agreement of seven [7] projects-namely Kopili Hydro power Station, Khandong Power station,

Assam Gas Based Power Station, Agartala Gas Based Power Station, Doyang Hydro Power Station,

Panyor Lower Hydro Power Station, Formerly known as Ranganadi HEP and Khandond Stage - II

has expired, as such it seeks the approval for the renewal of the draft Power Purchase Agreement

(PPA) of all the seven project.

3. While going through the petition and draft Power Purchase Agreement, it is noted that, the

petitioner has not submitted the need of renewing the Power Purchase Agreement supported with

power requirement.

4. The petitioner duly admits no such documents has been placed for consideration and further

sought a one [1] month time to submit the required information.

5. As prayed by the petitioner, the Commission allowed one [1] month time for submission of those

relevant documents which substantiate the necessity of these PPA's in view of power requirement

of petitioner.
