- Vide R.O.P dated 18. 06. 2025, the petitioner was directed to submit documents which
 were to be taken into consideration to justify the need of renewing the Power Purchase
 Agreement supported with power requirement.
- 3. The Commission has observed that the present petition suffers from anomalies and not in conformity with the data on record. The data on Resource adequacy and Power Procurement Plans submitted previously do not concur with the data of the present petition. The upcoming generation data has also not been reflected in the affidavit nor in the petition. The petition appear to be demand focused and lacks a comprehensive power procurement strategy, coherent with the already supplied data.
- 4. In lack of required documents, the petitioner is directed to submit a revised compliance affidavit incorporating detailed demand- supply projection and consistent with previously submitted comprehensive procurement plan and Resource adequacy Plan.
- 5. The Commission further allowed one [1] month time for submission of revised affidavit and required documents to substantiate the necessity of these Power Purchase Agreements.
- The matter for further hearing is fixed on 02. 09. 2025 at 11 A.M in Commission's Court Room.
