Record of Proceedings

(Date of Hearing: 08.12.2025)

- 1) The Commission heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner.
- 2) The learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that they will make all necessary arrangements for the projects to ensure proper accountability. He further informed that, in consultation with the Department of Power, they will carry out all required metering works and keep the Commission informed about the progress as and when the work is completed.
- 3) On behalf of Respondent No. 2, Mrs. Mogum Jini Riba, Executive Engineer (Western Zone), appeared before the Commission. Upon being queried by the Commission, she agreed to the proposal of the Petitioner.

- 4) After hearing the submissions of both the Petitioner and the Respondent, the Commission observed that, as per the ROP dated 14.05.2025, the Petitioner was required to furnish the following documents:
 - i. Detailed Project Report (DPR) or Feasibility Study Report for each project
 - ii. Project Completion Certificate
 - iii. Details of the project sanctioning authority along with corresponding funds received for each project from the State Government / MNRE / Government of India.
 - iv. Detailed capital cost statement for each individual project.
 - v. Any corresponding letter for getting approval from the competent authority for selling electricity in terms of PPA /connection agreement.

However, the Petitioner has only partially furnished the information but without the substantiating documents, which are essentially required for admission and determination of the tariff petition.

Therefore, the Commission directs the Petitioner to submit the copies of the documents and the detailed capital cost statements within a further period of two weeks from the date of issuance of this ROP. Failing which, the tariff petition shall stand dismissed.
