Advertisement for Engagement of Expert Consultants in the Engineering Wing of APSERC

1.0 SCOPE OF WORK FOR THE EXPERT CONSULTANTS IN ENGINEERING WING:

APSERC proposes to engage Expert Consultants, the duties and responsibilities of which shall include but not limited to as mentioned below:

- 1.1 Advice on all related technical matters pertaining to regulation or any other matter arising out of Electricity Act,2003
- 1.2 Providing engineering inputs on matters pertaining to tariff (tariff petitions, review petitions, truing-up petitions) in case of Hydro, Gas Based, Renewable projects(mainly Solar, Small Hydro, Wind, Bio Gas), Transmission and Distribution assets of State Govt., State Public Sector Undertakings, Private companies and Transmission licensees.
- 1.3 Assisting the Commission for due diligence of materials used as inputs for generation such as cost of plant & machinery, transportation, cost of fuel, transportation, taxes & duties etc. and any other related aspects. Sample checking of invoices, revenues, transfer price, if required and suggestappropriate modalities for the same.
- 1.4 Assisting the Commission for due diligence of the project documents including contract documents.
- 1.5 Matters related to petitions on open access, UI and Regulation.
- 1.6 To carry out Engineering / Technical analysis.
- 1.7 Providing inputs on Engineering aspects for framing of various new regulations, review, improvement, updating and amendments of existing Regulations.
- 1.8 Scrutinizing applications for intra-state transmission licenses.
- 1.9 Power system studies related to sharing of intra-state transmission charges and losses.
- 1.10 Scrutinizing applications for adoption of tariff in cases of Case-I and Case-II bidding and Intrastate transmission licensees.
- 1.11 Providing inputs for yearly determination of generic tariff from the renewable source of energy.
- 1.12 Providing input for Parliament Questions, Standing Committee Questions, preparing briefs/presentations and experts comments for the Commission in respect of various

- technical reports received from Forum of Regulators, Ministry of Power and other agencies, preparing of concept papers/policy papers.
- 1.13 Detailed analysis of DPRs submitted by the petitionersfordetermining the acceptable capital cost of Small Hydro projects, bench marking of O&M expenses, providing inputs for reduction in AT&C Losses, increase in operating efficiency of existing SHPs, analysis of power purchase and other similar issues of importance for the State Govt. Utilities.
- 1.14 Monitoring and ensuring of regulatory compliance by the utilities and the generating companies.
- 1.15 Any other miscellaneous work of the Commission as entrusted to him by the Secretary of the Commission.

2.0 **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**:

- 2.1 Normal working hours would be eight and half hours starting from 9.30 am during summer and 9 am during winter or as prescribed by the Commission from time to time(05 days week) including half hour lunch break. The personnel may be called on a Saturday, Sunday and other gazetted holidays, and also asked to sit beyond normal working hours in case of necessity.
- 2.2 There will be a provision of 15 days leave (including 8 days casual leave and seven days on the pattern of earned leave but not encashable) in a calendar year subject to prior sanction.
 - 2.3 Consultants appointed shall be governed by the provisions of the APSERC Appointment of Consultants Regulations-2017 and as amended from time to time and in future too.

3.0 DURATION OF CONTRACT:

The contract will be initially for a period of two years which can be extended up to five years. In deserving cases an annual escalation as deemed fit by the Commission may be given based on the performance during preceding year.

4.0 PAYMENT TERMS:

The consultant shall be paid lump sum monthly remuneration (the agreed amount) on completion of the month. TDS shall be deducted as per Income Tax rules.

5.0 TERMINATION OF CONTRACTS:

The assignment may be terminated earlier by either the employer or the employee by giving one month's notice, or one month's salary in lieu thereof. Provided, in case of disciplinary action the notice period shall not apply to APSERC.

- 6.0 Appointment under this assignment shall be on purely contract basis for a limited period only. Such appointment shall not vest any right to claim for regular appointment or continued contractual appointments in APSERC.
- 7.0 APSERC reserves the right not to fill up all or any of the above-mentioned position.
- 8.0 Only short listed candidates will be called for an interaction with the Selection Committee.
- 9.0 The Consultant will work in a team of other Expert Consultant and Staff Consultants guided by the Commission.
